OrADE continues to be an active chapter, triumphing over the pandemic and all the challenges it presented. In the last six months, OrADE chapter held a Halloween Costume contest (virtual), raised funds for a Domestic Violence Shelter, participated in an Alzheimer's walk, hosted an Ugly Sweater and Gingerbread House decorating contest (virtual), partnered with a local mental health agency to provide needed items for the holidays, and held a NADE membership drive.
