Since August 2022, I have:

- Communicated with the Chapter Presidents to encourage them to be active with their events and membership recruitment.

Alabama: Nothing to report

Georgia: Our Chapter activities continue to be impacted by COVID-19 and hybrid work schedule. We have suffered a decline in membership and the loss of several board members, but we continue to find ways to keep our members active.

GADE Activities this year:

- <u>Veterans Day Virtual Wall of Honor:</u> GADE created a video celebrating the service of all veterans during the week of November 7.
- Christmas Angel Tree: GADE collected Christmas gifts and donations during the month of December. We were able to donate over \$1000 in cash and gifts to the Wellroot Family Services (children in foster care). Our cash donation was matched by a Wellroot donor, which doubled the impact.

North Carolina: THADE has been very busy over the last few months. In October THADE worked in conjunction with DDS management to celebrate the staff with Employee Appreciation Week. During the week, THADE members organized unit competitions, and on Wednesday THADE along with our executive management team provided a BBO complete with a DJ. Our Ways and Means Committee has been busy as well with four fundraisers including Krispy Kreme card sales, Basket raffle, Jolly Grams, and the return of our Silent Auction. These events have raised a total of \$1547.90 for THADE. The Social Committee hosted a Fall Social in November where our members got together for snacks and door prizes. This provided a great chance for the members working in the building to get together and catch which more difficult in a hybrid telework environment. Our Community Service Committee has celebrated our Veteran's with snack baskets. And we facilitated a drive for donations to go to Resources for Seniors. We adopted three specific seniors, and not only met needs they had, but we also were able to provide supplies for the facility to give out to others in need. Finally, THADE had a very successful membership drive to day (2/2/2023), we have 16 new members. We raffled off one membership (\$50) to one of our new members, and another lucky member received a very large cookie basket.
