What is the Blue Envelope Program

Ongoing training to improve law enforcement interactions

What is the Blue Envelope Program?

- The Blue Envelope Program improves communication between law enforcement and community members with disabilities such as autism spectrum disorders, dementia, or other conditions that may impact communication.
- Drivers with communication barriers.
- Participants store essential documents in a bright blue envelope, signaling the potential need for additional communication accommodations during interactions with law enforcement.
- Participation is voluntary, there's no registry, and the envelopes are free.

Blue Envelope

Contents:

- Copy of Driver's License
- Vehicle Registration
- Insurance

Instructions to First Responder:

(Officer, Firefighter, EMT)

- Speak calmly and relaxed
- Speak in lower volume
- Avoid shouting/loud noises
- Approach slowly
- Do not touch
- · Turn off bright lights

Tips for Interacting with Police:

Do:

- · Hand the officer your blue envelope
- Take a deep breath and listen to questions
- · Keep your hands visible to the officer

Don't:

- Reach for things without permission
- · Leave without permission


